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Background:	The City Manager is requesting approval of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Coastal Florida Police Benevolent Association (PBA) and the City of Rockledge that will provide for the assignment of Fire Inspector/Plan Reviewer by the Public Safety Director and for compensation for duties performed, as well as the weekly work schedule, while serving as a Fire Inspector/Plan Reviewer.

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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Re: Fire Inspector/Plan Reviews

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) shall be incorporated as Section J of Article 18 [WAGES] of the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of Rockledge and the Coastal Florida Police Benevolent Association. Such inclusion shall occur within the contract amendments for 2018. This MOU will become effective upon signature by representatives of both parties.

ARTICLE 18
WAGES

[Sections A through I are pre-existing.]

- J. Assignment to the position of Fire Inspector/Plan Reviews will take place through appointment by the Public Safety Director/Chief of Police or his designee.
1. As compensation for duties performed while assigned as a Fire Inspector/Plan Reviews, officers will receive an additional \$96.00 per week assignment pay. Should the appointment/assignment to the position of Fire Inspector/Plan Reviews be terminated by the Public Safety Director/Chief of Police, the assignment pay will be rescinded.
 2. It is the declared policy and intent of the City that the regular workweek of the Fire Inspector/Plan Reviews shall consist of a flex schedule of eighty four (84) hours worked in seven (12) hour periods, as approved by the Director of Public Safety/Chief of Police or his designee.
