Chairman Inman called the meeting to order at 2:30 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss a request by Trauger Consulting Engineers, P.O. Box 360253, Melbourne, Florida on behalf of City of Cocoa, 65 Stone Street, Cocoa, Florida. The City of Cocoa is planning a redevelopment project, Villas of Cocoa Village, that will be primarily located in the Cocoa Village area, but a portion of the site falls within City of Rockledge jurisdiction. The applicant is requesting a waiver of the 100-year storm event requirement set forth in Land Development Regulations; a 25-year storm design requirement is requested in conjunction with Community Redevelopment incentive guidelines.

Motion by City Manager Fettrow to approve the applicant request to allow for a 25-year storm event design on stormwater; motion seconded by Building Official Callahan. The motion carried unanimously.
