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## **PORTABLE STORAGE UNITS (PSU)**

One (1) portable storage unit is allowed on a property at any one time. The size is not to exceed eight (8) feet tall, eight (8) feet wide, and sixteen (16) feet in length.

PSU must be placed in such a manner that it doesn't impair the view of a motor vehicle operator seeing vehicular, pedestrian or bicycle traffic either on or off the property.

PSU cannot be located so that it obstructs the flow of vehicular, pedestrian or bicycle traffic.

PSU may have affixed to it no more than two (2) twelve inch by eighteen inch (12"X18") signs. The storage unit must have a tag affixed to it indicating the most recent date the unit was delivered to the property.

PSU may be placed on a residential property for a four (4) day period, no more than four (4) times in a twelve-month period. Non-residential property may have a unit for a thirty (30) day period, four times per year.

No living creature is ever allowed to reside or be stored in a portable storage unit for any reason.

In the event of a predicted high wind event (hurricane) with predicted winds of 74+mph, the portable storage unit must be removed to an approved storage area before the storm is due to arrive. If not done, the City will remove it and charge the property owner accordingly.

Any PSU not removed at the end of the allowed time in place, or found to be in violation of this code for safety reasons may be removed by the City without notice, and all costs associated with the removal will be assessed against the property upon which the unit was placed. If costs are not paid upon demand, a lien will be filed against the property by the city.
